

Freelance Contractor & Media Instructor Positions Available

The Public Access Corporation of DC (DCTV) is accepting resumes for television production freelancers and instructors skilled in all aspects of video production, including: studio, ENG camera, editing and/or the ability to train students in one or all of these areas.

Freelancers can earn up to \$150 per shoot and instructors can earn up to \$300 per training course. Wages are based on applicant's level of experience.

Most studio shoots range from 3-4 hours; field shoots are typically between 5-6 hours and instructors normally train small groups of 4-8 people, once a week from 4-6 weeks—depending on the course.

DCTV is a membership-based, non-profit, public access television station dedicated to building communities through telecommunications. Since 1988, DCTV has allowed residents of the District of Columbia, young and old, the opportunity to create and telecast their own shows for DC communities on cable television. Our Mission is:

- To provide opportunities for community residents and organizations to create noncommercial television programs and telecast them on cable channels on a fair and equitable basis, free of censorship or editorial control.
- To engage the entire community in a dialogue that is broadly representative of its varied perspectives and cultures.
